FINANCIAL CLOSE FOR TUASONE WASTE-TO-ENERGY PLANT, SINGAPORE'S LARGEST WASTE-TO-ENERGY PROJECT

Singapore, 16 May 2016 – Hyflux Ltd (Hyflux or The Group) is pleased to announce that the consortium comprising Hyflux and Mitsubishi Heavy Industries (MHI), through its project company, TuasOne Pte Ltd (TuasOne), has achieved financial close for the project financing of TuasOne Waste-to-Energy (WTE) plant.

TuasOne secured a S\$653 million 27-year term loan facility which will be used to finance the development, construction and start-up costs of the WTE plant. The project financing is provided by DBS Bank Ltd, Maybank Kim Eng Securities Pte Ltd, Mizuho Bank Ltd and The Bank of Tokyo-Mitsubishi UFJ Ltd who are the lead arrangers, underwriters and bookrunners for the facility.
